The questions on the test will consist of TWO parts:

**Part 1: Multiple Choice/Matching** - these will test things like the concepts we have studied in this unit, your comprehension of the story AND whether you can identify literary terms in the context of a sentence.

**Part 2: PEE Chain Format Response** – answering question(s) similar to those we have been practicing in class so far this year.

**Preparation for this test:**

1. Study all notes and practice answers completed in your Language exercise book and all study handouts in the Step Up section of your Language duotang.

2. Know the concepts that we have covered so far this year:

- setting
- mood
- point of view
- text-to-text connections
- text-to-world connections
- text-to-self connections
- conflict (internal - human vs. self, external - human vs. society, human vs. human, human vs. nature)
- plot (including: exposition, complication, climax, falling action, and resolution)
- theme
- character
- character trait
- suspense
- foreshadowing

3. **Note:** memorizing these concepts *is not* enough. Most importantly, you must know how to ***apply*** them to a story. As part of this, please study answers done so far in exercise book, especially ***model answers***.
