Listening Effectively

Active Listening:

- * **Active Listening** involves using strategies to better understand oral texts.
- * Here are some strategies that you can use to become an *active* listener:
 - 1) Make *connections* with what you are hearing.

(i.e. text-to-self, text-to-text or text-to-world connections.)

- 2) Visualize the information.
- 3) Ask relevant questions of the speaker or yourself to keep yourself focused.
- 4) Repeat or summarize what you hear.
- 5) Identify point of view.
- * You need to experiment with the different strategies to find out which one works best for you.
- * You may use only one of the above strategies or a variety of them to become the best *active* listener that you can be!
